- Current balance is \$5,952.54
 - **Expenses:** \$70 State of Florida annual filing, \$150 in Dunkin Donut gift cards, \$150 Target gift cards for teacher attendance rewards
 - Dance expenses: \$116.66 pizza, \$300 DJ, \$234.24 decorations and giveaways
 - Upcoming expense: Teacher Appreciation
 - **Income:** \$670.10 profit from the dance
 - Upcoming Income: “Culver’s” Spirit Night, Silent Auction

OLD BUSINESS

Spring Dance

- PTO usually earns \$2,000 from the dance with roughly 250 tickets sold, but this year only 95 students attended
- It could be the date and theme change – next year PTO will consider moving it back and keeping the “Super Bowl Sweetheart” theme to align with the Super Bowl and Valentine’s Day

- PTO has 5 more totes to store in the custodial area on the PTO shelving
